

Starting from AY2020-21, students are welcome to enroll in Level 3 GE Capstone courses, including the six GCAP courses offered by the Department of History.

**For BA (Hons) in History students:**

If you enroll in GCAP 3025/ 3006/ 3007/ 3015/ 3016/ 3155, it will be double-counted towards SOSC 3005, hence you will satisfy both the GE level-3 capstone requirement and three units of the Social Sciences Common Core requirement. For the released units, you will simply replace them with a 3-unit HIST course of your choice.

**For students who target to declare a history minor:**

To declare a history minor, you are required to take at least 5 courses offered by the History Department during your study. You can replace one of the courses with GCAP 3025/ 3007/ 3015/ 3016/ 3155 in order to fulfill the requirement. Please note that only one GCAP course will be double-counted among all minor courses.
