

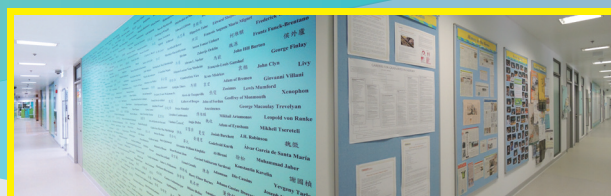
RESEARCH AREAS
