RESEARCH / TEACHING AREAS

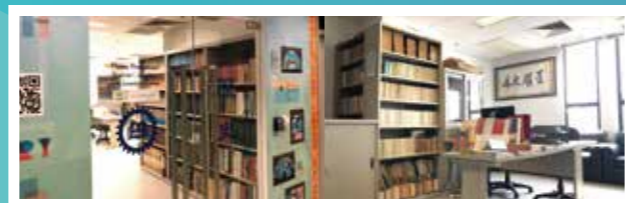
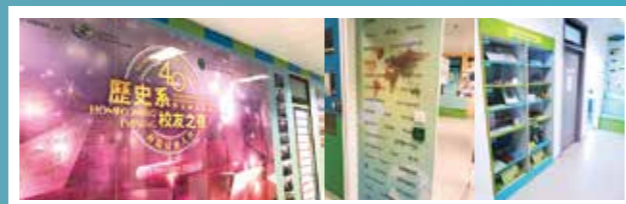
