Of Trees, a Son, and Kingship:  
Recovering an Ancient Chinese Dream

◆ Abstract

The first volume of the Tsinghua University Warring States bamboo-strip manuscripts contains a text with passages that match medieval quotations of a text referred to as Cheng wu 程寤 or Awakening at Cheng, which in turn is said to be a lost chapter of the Yi Zhou shu 逸周書 or Leftover Zhou Documents. The passages concern one of Chinese literature's earliest interpretations of a dream, and were quoted in medieval encyclopedias in their sections on dreams. I discuss the significance of this discovery both for Chinese textual history and also for the interpretation of this particular dream.

◆ 內容提要

《清華大學藏戰國竹簡(壹)》載有一篇文獻與中國中古時代類書所引《逸周書·程寤》段落非常相似。這些段落記載中國文學上最早夢占之一。本文討論這一文獻對中國文獻學和中國夢占學的意義，利用傳統文獻學原則提出一種新的夢占。
