## Bio

Alexander Lukin is Academic Head of the Institute of China and Contemporary Asia of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Head of the Department of International Relations at National Research University Higher School of Economics, Director of the Center for Chinese, East Asian and Shanghai Cooperation Organization Studies at Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO University) and Chair Professor in the School of Public Affairs at Zhejiang University (China). He received his first degree from MGIMO University in 1984, a doctorate in politics from Oxford University in 1997, a doctorate in history from Russian Diplomatic Academy in 2007 and a professional development degree in theology from St. Tikhon's Orthodox University in 2013. He is the author of *The Political Culture of the Russian Democrats* (Oxford University Press, 2000), *The Bear Watches the Dragon: Russia's Perceptions of China and the Evolution of Russian-Chinese Relations since the Eighteenth Century* (M.E.Sharpe, 2003), *Grasping Russia with your Mind* (with Pavel Lukin, Ves' Mir, 2015, in Russian), *Pivot to Asia: Russia's Foreign Policy Enters the 21st Century* (Vij Books India, 2016), *China and Russia: The New Rapprochement* (Polity, 2018), *Russia: A Thorny Transition from Communism* (Vij Books India, 2019), as well as numerous articles and policy papers on international relations, Russian and Chinese politics. He also edits the journal *Russian China Studies* which he founded in 2022.
