Bio

Dr Raphael Wong is Associate Curator at the Hong Kong Palace Museum, and a Bei Shan Tang Scholar with a DPhil in archaeology from the University of Oxford. His research focuses on China, West Asia, and the Eurasian Steppes of the 1st millennium BC. Dr Wong worked previously at the Art Museum and in the Department of Fine Arts of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, where he was involved in several exhibitions and catalogue projects. He is lead curator of the exhibitions "Radiance: Ancient Gold from the Hong Kong Palace Museum Collection and the Mengdiexuan Collection", "Clay to Treasure: Ceramics from the Palace Museum Collection", "The Making of Masterpieces: Chinese Painting and Calligraphy from the Palace Museum", and other upcoming exhibitions at the Hong Kong Palace Museum.
