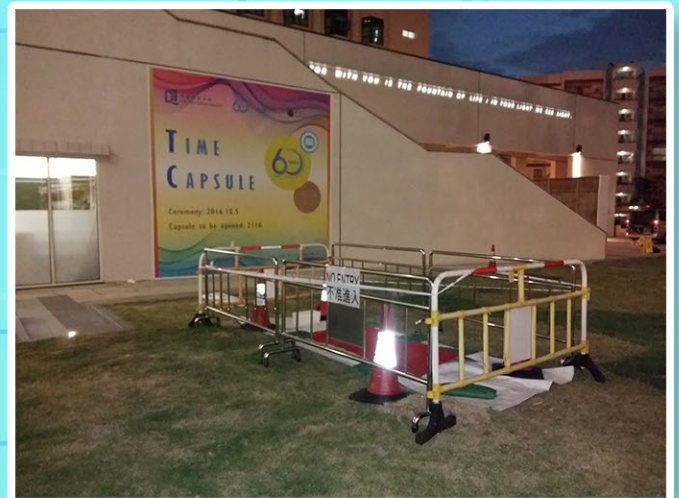
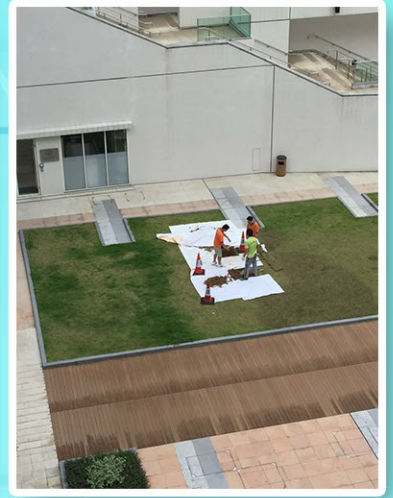
DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

The Centennial Time Capsule Ceremony was successfully held by the History Department 5 October 2016 (Wed) in celebration of the 60th anniversary of Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU) and the 45th anniversary of the Faculty of Social Sciences (SOSC).

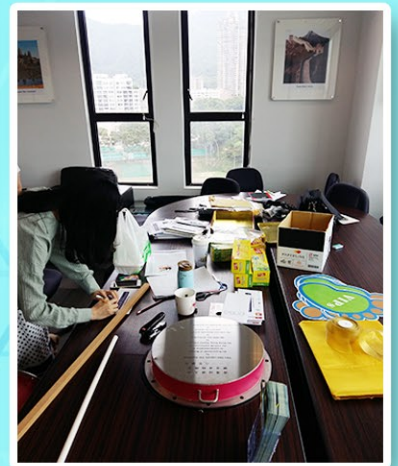
As the most important event of the Department in AY2016-17, the preparation of this project took nearly a year with the support of the Estates Office of the University. The time capsule, which will be sealed for 100 years, was placed in the Meeting Room on 4 October 2016 (Tue) before the actual burial. Members of the Department, including faculty members, staff, History Majors, came and contributed their items into the time capsule as well as took photos to preserve the memorable moment. Some History Majors served as student helpers to group the items and put them into

the water-proof bags, then systematically put the items into the time capsule. The various items placed into the time capsule included a significant number of paper-form messages, images, and selected objects contributed by students, colleagues, alumni and supporters. The time capsule also contained souvenirs of HKBU's 60th anniversary and SOSC's 45th anniversary, publicity materials and publications of the Department as well as a set of current stationery items. Members were excited to witness the sealing of the time capsule on that day. In addition, overnight security service was arranged for ensuring safety.

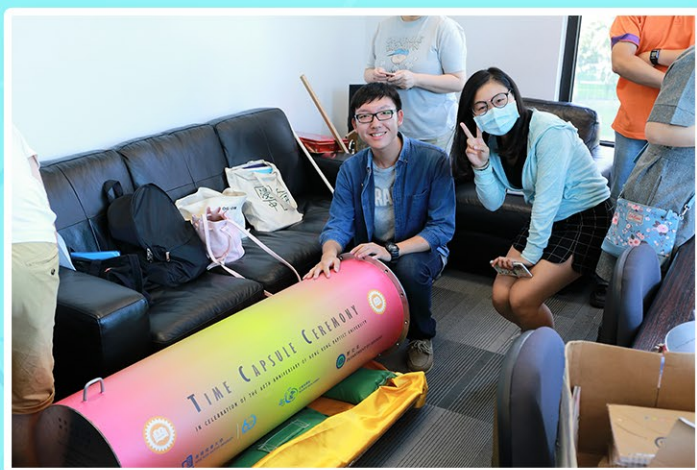
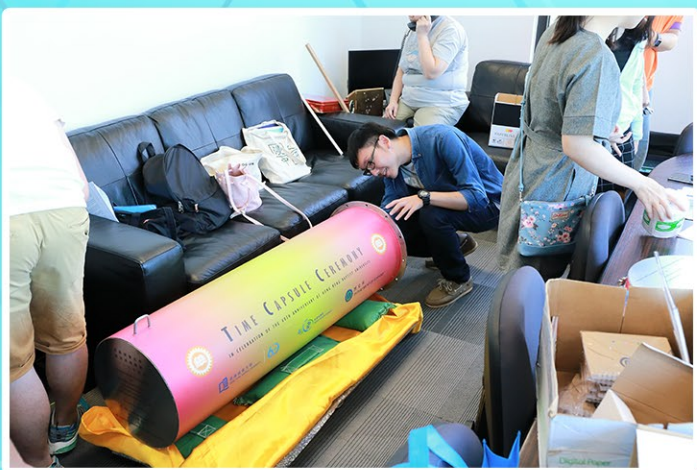
The time capsule burial site before 5 October 2016

On 5 October 2016, Professor Roland Chin, President and Vice-Chancellor, Professor Franklin Luk, Vice-President (Academic), Professor Rick Wong, Vice-President (Research & Development), Dr. Albert Chau, Vice-President (Teaching & Learning), Mr. Andy Lee, Vice-President (Administration) and Secretary, Professor Frank Fu, Associate Vice-President and Chairman of 60th Anniversary Co-ordinating Committee, Professor Adrian Bailey, Dean of Faculty of Social Sciences, and Professor Clara Ho served as officiating members for the Ceremony. Many members of the HKBU community, including students, academic and administrative staff of different departments / units, alumni, relevant student organizations, and external supporters, also attended this special occasion. Dr. Catherine Ladds and Dr. Sammy Kin-sum Li served as Masters of the Ceremony on that day.

In the ceremony, Rev. Dr. King-tak Ip (Class of 1977), Chaplain of HKBU and alumnus of the Department, was invited to lead the participants to sing along the University Anthem. Moreover, Mr. Joseph Liu (Class of 2013) and Miss Simone Lee (Class of 2016), both alumni of the History Department, led a chorus of History Majors in singing the History Department Anthem on stage. Guests were fascinated with the first public performance of the Department Anthem.



Professor Chin and Professor Clara Ho delivered speeches. They welcomed all the guests and extended their gratitude and appreciation to members of the HKBU community for their support and participation in this historic occasion to celebrate HKBU's 60th anniversary and SOSC's 45th anniversary.

In Professor Chin's speech, he said that 100 years from now, HKBU will still strive to excel. He believes that though things will change, the three DNAs of HKBU, namely care and compassion; creativity and global outlook, would remain intact, passing from one generation to the next. He expressed his sincere hopes that HKBU will continue making history for the next one hundred years. He explained that the collaborative Time Capsule Project, in which every member could participate by contributing their favorite items, was a testimony to the strength of our university community and it sent a clear message that it was up to us to construct our own history. He believed that the time capsule will stay with members of HKBU community for the next 100 years and it will become the university's tangible cultural heritage to future generations. He also pointed out that a stone stele will be erected upon the capsule site after the Ceremony, which will become a symbol of our university community.

In Professor Ho's speech, she said that in traditional Chinese culture, 100 has always been a great number symbolizing luck, longevity, endurance, and perfection, while Western cultures also regard 100 as perfection. Due to the gracious meanings of 100, the Department of History decided to let the time capsule stay for a century, to be opened in 2116. The opening of the capsule will certainly be an event that will stir excitement among the University community at that time. She showed her appreciation to the most distinguished officiating team that the Department has ever had, and thanked members

for making another historical record for the Department. Moreover, she also took the opportunity to express her sincerest gratitude to the senior administration for granting the Department a piece of land to bury the time capsule, to Estates Office's colleagues for their full support, and to a number of offices at HKBU, especially SOSC Faculty, Communication and Public Relations Office and the University Library, for their active participation in contributing items to enrich the time capsule. She also thanked donors and alumni for their support by making donations and contributing items. In sum, she thanked all participants for witnessing the historic occasion created by the Department on that day.

After the speeches, all members of the officiating team were invited to perform the ribbon-cutting ceremony on stage. Two Associate Vice-Presidents, several faculty Deans, donors and members of the History Department Advisory Committee as well as all faculty members of the Department were invited on stage to take several group photos with the officiating team. Two grand group photos of all participants were taken with two big wall stickers celebrating HKBU's 60th anniversary as background.







Professor Chin held the electronic controller to deposit the time capsule and shovel soil onto the time capsule to symbolize the beginning of the 100-year life of the time capsule. Other officiating members and three student representatives from the three programmes of the History Department, including Ka-wai Lai (BA [Hons] in History, Year 4), Kit-hung Ng (BSSc [Hons] in China Studies – History Concentration, Year 3), and Hin Lam (BA [Hons] in History and BEd [Hons] in Liberal Study Teaching, Year 4), split into three groups to shovel dirt together. All participants were thrilled to witness the most important symbolic act of the Ceremony and took photos to preserve the historical moment. Meanwhile, Dr. Ladds and Dr. Li officially announced that anyone who uses the 2116 invitation card to attend the Time Capsule Opening Ceremony in the AD 2116 will be treated as a VIP by the future colleagues of the Department and reminded all participants to pass the card along to the next generation.

After the Ceremony, all participants enjoyed a reception with quality refreshments and some kinds of entertainment: picking up shovels to bury the time capsule, taking photos next to the time capsule burial site or in front of the gorgeous backdrop and wall sticker of the Department. The Ceremony was a great success and the pleasing atmosphere allowed guests to relax and enjoy the festivity of the event.





The time capsule, to be opened in 2116, was buried in the Entrance Plaza of Baptist University Road Campus. It was created by historians for historians of the future and was designed as a tool to preserve “our time.” All members of HKBU community collaborated in the creation of the time capsule as it contains items (texts, images, and objects), which were selected by using our professional judgment. Significantly, a memorial stone stele will be erected on the site after the Ceremony.

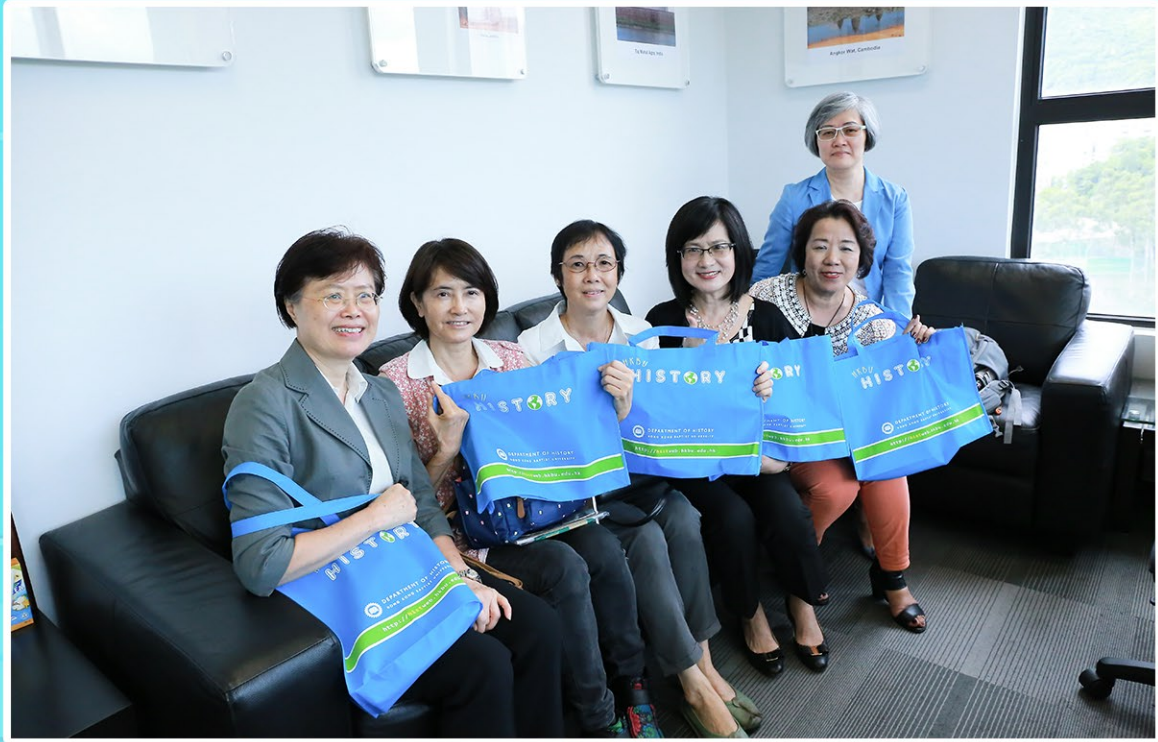

HKBU Received Donation in Support of History Project (2016.10.19)

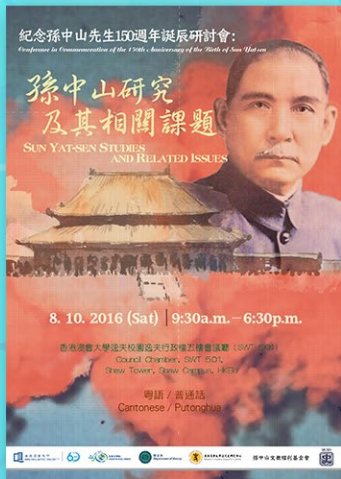

Members of the Information Day Committee, including Dr. Wing-chung Fan, Dr. Jie Ding, Dr. Kam-chau Kwok, Dr. Raymond Kwun-sun Lau and Dr. Yuen-han Law, coordinated their efforts with the General Office team, research post-graduate students, and undergraduate student helpers to set up panel displays and to introduce the features of the History Department. They offered key information about the admission requirements, programme structures, course details, and career opportunities. Up-to-date informative leaflets were distributed to the visitors.

Lecture on “The Japanese Perception of the Sino-Japanese War” (2016.10.19)



Prof. Agnes Chan 陳美齡教授 was invited by Prof. Cindy Yik-yi Chu to deliver a lecture about “The Japanese Perception of the Sino-Japanese War” in the tutorial class of HIST3116 “Foreign Relations of Modern China” on 19 October 2016 (Wed).

In Prof. Chan’s lecture, she firstly gave a general overview of the Second Sino-Japanese War (1937-1945). She explained that most of the Japanese failed to recognize the actual situation during the wartime period due to Japanese government’s censorship before 1945. As mass media was controlled by the government, lack of proper information visibility led to Japanese low level of awareness about the war. Moreover, she pointed out the economic benefits of the war were energetically promoted by the Japanese government as a makeup for the invasion of China.

In addition, Prof. Chan indicated one of the important factors, which affects Japanese understanding on the Sino-Japanese War in the post-war period, is the shame culture in Japan. She explained that Japanese society has been restricted by this culture and its underlying impact causes that Japan refuses to recognize and bear responsibility for its war crimes.

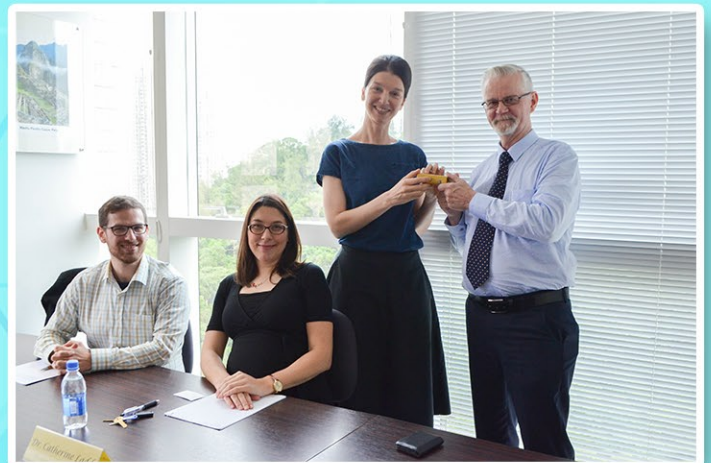


MHRC Colloquium: "Port City Communities" (2016.10.20)



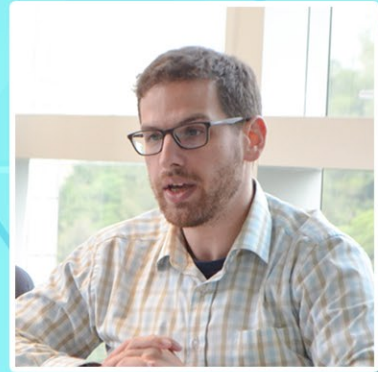
The "MHRC Colloquium: 'Port City Communities'," organized by the History Department and Modern History Research Centre, was held at AAB 1153 on 20 October 2016 (Thu). Historians from Germany, Netherlands, Britain and the U.S. generated a lively discussion to produce and exchange research findings and insights about the theme in multidisciplinary analysis.

The Colloquium was hosted by Dr. Bettina Dietz, Associate Director of MHRC. Three speakers, including Prof. Paul van Dyke (Sun Yat-sen University, Guangzhou), Dr. Catherine Ladds, and Dr. David Schley, delivered presentations on "Eighteenth-Century Canton – where Local meets Global," "Marginal People in Liminal Places: Non-Elite Europeans in Early Twentieth-Century East Asian Port Cities," and "Disruptive Mobility: Infrastructure, Traffic, and Community in a Nineteenth-Century Port City (Baltimore)" respectively.



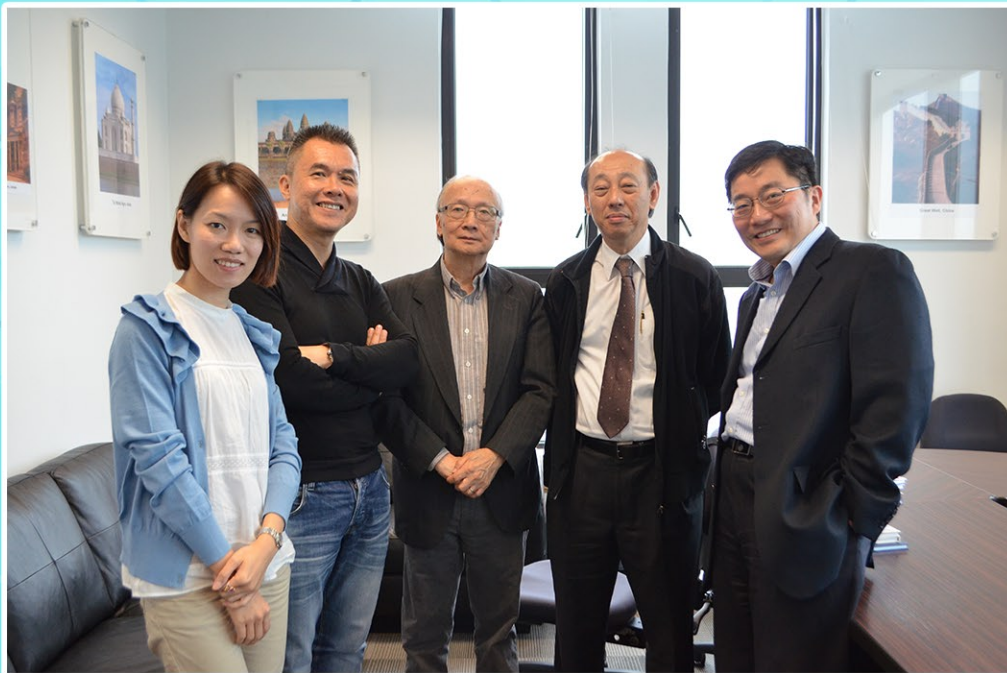
Dr. Bettina Dietz presented souvenir to Prof. Paul van Dyke.





Prof. van Dyke discussed the growth of international trade, maritime systems, policies related to port operations that affect local communities as well as cultural and ideological exchanges between foreigners and Chinese in Canton during the late 18th & early 19th centuries. Besides, Dr. Ladds investigated the marginal mobility and the emergence of multiple nationality phenomenon of Europeans in East Asian port cities by exploring the colorful family history of Edith Brentnall. Moreover, Dr. Schley elaborated the relation of the economic growth and the construction of Baltimore & Ohio Railroad in Baltimore during the early 19th century. He highlighted the establishment of railroad in transforming mobility and livability in the port city but he also indicated the challenges of railroad's construction and complexities of issues affecting daily lives of citizens, such as railroad safety issues that caused anti-railroad movements in Philadelphia.

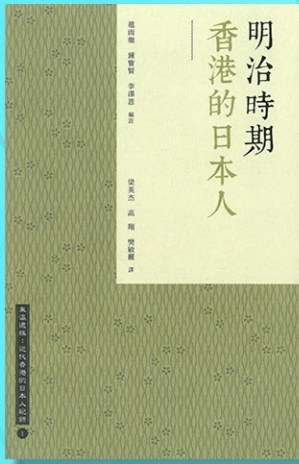

簡介：

十九世紀中葉的亞太地區，正經歷風起雲湧的政治變革，西力東漸下衰微的中國，率先喪失了香港。香港也逐漸朝英國殖民地的管治方式發展，漸漸晉身為亞洲先進的行列。

關於香港，日本人從來不感到陌生。《明治時期香港的日本人》即為日本領事記錄香港事件與民衆的文本，平實而細緻，既反映了日本早期領事工作的艱難，又忠實記錄了日本領事與中國官僚、香港政要各類官方交往，儼然是東亞外交史的一個縮影。

本書對香港的金融、港口、商企、行業的記錄，對英、法、美等西方列強的軍事布置的關注，對在港日人見聞的記載，既有別於殖民地政府的英文史料，也有別於晚清的中文史料，猶如觀察香港的第三隻眼睛。藉助這一新視角，或可幫助我們發現香港為人所忽略的歷史。
