Kick-off Ceremony for the History Department's 40th Anniversary and A Conversation with an Outstanding Alumna Ms. Lo Koon Lan

歷史系四十周年系慶開幕典禮暨傑出校友分享 (2018.2.2)



The Department of History is turning 40 in 2018. To celebrate this significant milestone, a Kick-off Ceremony for the Anniversary and a sharing by an outstanding alumna, Ms. Lo Koon Lan (羅冠蘭), were held on 2 February 2018 (Friday) at SCM 012.

The event was jointly organized by the Department of History and Alumni Affairs Office and attracted 250 participants including HKBU senior management representatives, faculty members, administrative staff, History majors, students from other departments and the general public. Dr. Thomas Marling, Lecturer and Miss Zhihui Lin, PhD student at the History Department served as the event MC.



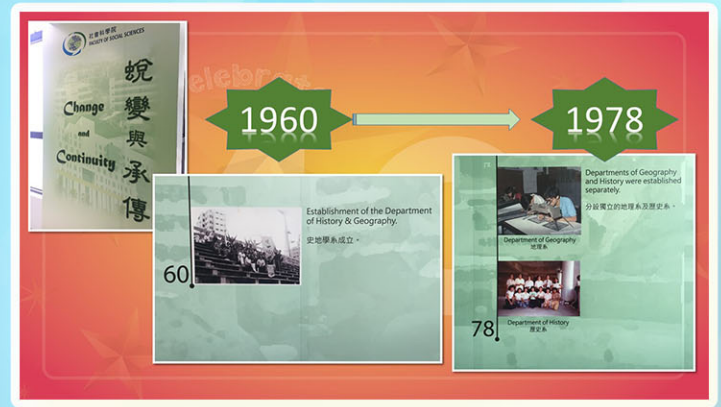


At the Kick-off Ceremony, Professor Roland Chin (President and Vice Chancellor), Professor Clayton Mackenzie (Provost), Professor Rick Wong [Vice-President (Research and Development)], Dr. Albert Chau, [Vice-President (Teaching and Learning)], Mr. CK Yeung [Associate Vice-President (Engagement)], Prof. Adrian J. Bailey, (Dean of Faculty of Social Sciences), Prof. Clara Wing-chung Ho (Head and Professor, Department of History), and Dr. Melanie Lee (Director, Alumni Affairs Office) served as officiating guests. Dr. Ip King Tak (Chaplain of HKBU) and Ms. Lo Koon Lan (former Associate Professor of the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts), distinguished alumni from the Class of 1977 also joined the stage. The Department would like to thank all senior management representatives for gracing the event with their presence.

In President Chin's welcoming remarks, he first extended his warmest blessings to the Department for reaching that far in the past 40 years. He was delighted to see many of the History graduates becoming successful leaders across different fields. He also mentioned two History majors who were the first in Hong Kong to win the CY Tung Scholarship. Their outstanding performance had impressed the Semester at Sea (SAS) program and opened the door of opportunities for subsequent HKBU students.



President Chin was invited to pull the string and unveil the curtain of the special designed TV Box, activating the new “History 40” website which lists all upcoming events and special announcements of the Department. A short video was played to record the department’s journey since 1970s.



The Department also prepared some special souvenir packs, including a newly designed memo pad and tasty chocolates as souvenir to every audience.

A conversation with an outstanding alumna Ms. Lo Koon Lan was held after the Kick-off Ceremony. The topic was “What Makes a History Major Love Acting?” Ms. Lo shared her path from a History major to a successful actress of the stage and the screen. Ms. Lo emphasized that studying History is like looking through a telescope so that she could learn from the past and be more alert when dealing with matters in life, while acting is like looking through a microscope so that she could experience the life of different characters and understand human nature thoroughly. By investigating different incidents and facts, she concluded that History was not a single event but interlinked, with many stories connecting tiny matters, and this is what makes History so interesting.





A Q&A session hosted by Dr. Wing-chung Fan and Dr. Yuen-han Law, alumni of the Department, was arranged after the sharing.

錢校長在致歡迎辭時首先恭賀歷史系走到第四十個年頭，他很高興看到不少歷史系畢業生在為社會上各有成就，希望未來也繼續培育人才，在不同行業上大放異彩。他特別提到2013年底歷史系學生成為首兩位香港學生獲頒「董浩雲獎學金」，並參與2014年春季為期四個月的「海上學府」郵輪交流，成功為浸大學生打開機會之門，藉不同交流和學習之旅擴闊眼界。

開幕慶典結束後，隨即舉行另一項焦點活動，由前香港演藝學院副教授、著名演員羅冠蘭女士主講公開講座。羅老師是前香港話劇團首席演員，曾參與及演出超過一百部舞台劇，同時亦擔任多齣電影及電視劇主要角色，曾經為香港大學、香港浸會大學、香港城市大學等設計和主持戲劇創作及「自我尋找」訓練課程。1994獲選為香港十大傑出青年。現主要從事教育工作及舞台劇創作，戲劇研究範圍包括寫實主義及荒誕劇，多年來獲獎無數，近年憑電影《寵我》獲頒十一項最佳女主角及一項最佳女配角之國際獎項。

是次羅老師重返母校，以「讀歷史的我怎會愛上演戲」為題，與在場學生分享她由讀歷史到成為演員的心路歷程。羅老師提到，讀歷史就像看著望遠鏡一樣，讓她從不同的歷史片段進行觀察，汲取經驗之餘亦學習應對生命中的難題；而演戲則像顯微鏡，讓她透過飾演不同角色，感受不同人的思想和性格，也徹底地了解各種人性。羅老師強調，歷史從不是個別及單一事件，而是由眾多小事蘊釀而成，環環緊扣。歷史的訓練有助她揣摩角色和探討背後的關係，這正是學習歷史的樂趣。

問答環節由同屬校友身份的歷史系講师范永聰博士及羅婉嫻博士主持，在場學生表現踴躍。

History Faculty Won Equipment Matching Fund – First Time for the Department



Dr. Sammy Kin-sum Li, Dr. Oiyen Liu, Dr. Chi-man Kwong and Dr. David Schley successfully secured an enormous amount of HK\$909,200, approved by the Research Committee, HKBU, as the first Equipment Matching Fund (2017/2018) for the Department.

The team will utilize the grant to purchase a 3D-scanning machine to 3D-scan massive scaled sites of cultural heritages for their research projects. The machine will facilitate the team in preserving data and displaying their work in a more systematic way. By preserving the meta-data of the settlements and communities, team members can expand the social impact of their research outcome and construct a better infrastructure when dealing with massive data and materials.

《休憩空間與歷史記憶：全球中山公園研究》出版

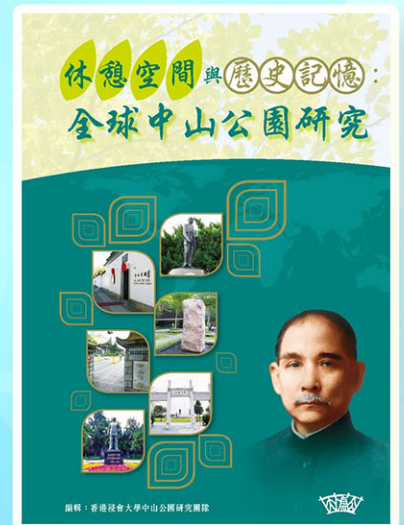

淘盡黃沙始見金——HIST/CHSH 4407南丫島大灣田野考察 HIST/CHSH 4407 Fieldtrip (2018.2.9)

二十世紀科學考古傳入中國後，中國的考古發展一日千里，人不惜力，地不藏金，考古遺址破土而出，為中國上古史帶來嶄新面貌及全新的研究視野。香港為處中國南方，在史前時期已與中原交通，在香港的南丫島大灣更發現史前遺址，確證香港在新石器時代已有先民居住。



為了讓同學更了解先民居住的生活環境及認識考古學，我於2018年2月9日帶領CHSH/HIST 4407——中國上古社會史的同學，親赴這個史前遺址考察。我們一行十數人由中環碼頭乘船到南丫島榕樹灣，再步行約十五分鐘到達大灣遺址。大灣遺址南瀕海灣，東、西有兩岬角，遺址東南隔山丘為洪聖爺灣，西北約300米是香港電燈公司發電廠。該遺址曾出土國寶級遺物牙璋，是證明史前時期中原的禮樂文明已經擴展到華南一帶的最佳證據，同學們在大灣遺址能體驗古人如何進行祭祀及了解先民祭祀的儀式。我們再沿南丫島家樂徑步行山上，在南丫島山腰的涼亭下能一覽大灣、洪聖爺灣及發電廠，在山上俯視能讓同學更立體地了解先民選擇大灣作活動場所的原因，配合水流、風向、附近資源、田野人類遺跡，同學基本能掌握新、舊石器時代遺址的劃分方法，又能指出附近具開採價值的遺址。

香港政府不重視考古發現，大灣遺址現時荒廢，既無任何標示指出這裡曾是考古遺址，曾出土重要遺物，更沒有任何保護遺址的措施，現時在遺址上更有渠務工程，任意開拓。同學們都感嘆香港史前史被人遺忘，保護遺址的意識薄弱，只能期望有更多香港人關心自身地區的史前史。

歷史學從來都不應是一門紙上談兵的學問，走出課室，離開講義，親身踏上遺址，呼吸與先民相同的空氣，是學習歷史的一個有效方法。淘盡黃沙始見金，考古學上，瀝盡所有黃沙能有國寶遺物出土，完成考察後，相信同學踏盡黃沙也能得到寶貴的歷史知識和經驗。

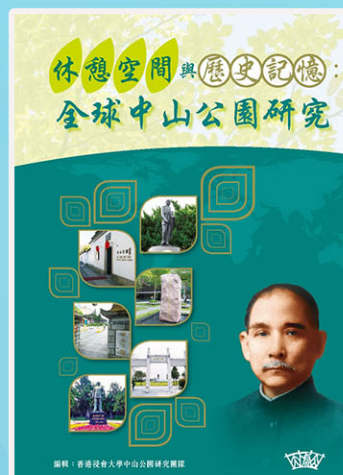

On sabbatical in São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Berlin, and Paris

After teaching at HKBU for seven years, I was granted my first sabbatical last semester. From June 2017 to January 2018, I went to Europe to do what I can't do while in Hong Kong: searching archives for my work on eighteenth-century history of science, and visiting libraries to read publications in European languages other than English. But my first stop was Brazil, where I participated in two conferences, one in São Paulo and the other one in Rio de Janeiro. Although both cities are huge and crowded, people on the street were very friendly to me when I had to ask for directions occasionally without speaking Portuguese. Once I got lost at a very large bus stop with almost no signs and had to ask a bus driver who prepared his double-decker for departure how to find the right line. Although he was about to leave he calmly put on his glasses, stuck his head out of the window to better hear me – I was using my bits and pieces of Italian with some Portuguese words in between – and explained me slowly where to go.



Next stop was Berlin, a city that has become a second home to me over the years. I circulated among different libraries that hold manuscript collections and printed works from the early modern period and saw some rare and surprising documents, for example a series of original drawings of the landscape and plants of the Cape of Good Hope that were made by a captain of the Dutch East India Company in the seventeenth century. Sometimes it is interesting to know how documents ended up in the possession of a certain library – but in this case I have not yet figured out what happened.

My host institution was a research centre in Paris that specializes in the history of science and technology. While there I continued roaming around libraries to locate manuscripts that are of interest to my research. Sometimes the most challenging thing is not finding them but being allowed to see and read them, particularly when they are either precious or in bad material condition – or both. I am happy to have seen even some of those. When I returned to Hong Kong in January I brought a wealth of notes and scans to work with over the next months.

年近歲晚，去年之事實屬過去，「也無風雨也無晴」也罷。筆者在此順頌諸君在戊戌年度一帆風順，遇事則處於泰然。



Becoming Eurasian: The Establishment of The Welfare League and Eurasian Identity in Inter-war Hong Kong

◆ Abstract

This paper examines the founding of Hong Kong's Welfare League in 1929, led by a group of prominent Eurasians in the colony. I argue that the founding of this organization was a watershed event in the institutionalization of Eurasian identity in pre-World War II Hong Kong. Prior to this time, many prominent Eurasians in the colony publicly claimed a Chinese identity, both as a means to escape colonial racism and as a means of upward mobility. I argue that an "ethnic shift" took place among Hong Kong's Eurasian community around the time of the formation of the Welfare League, leading many in the younger generation to publicly embrace a "Eurasian" identity. C.G. Anderson (1889-1949) played a leading role in defining a vision of this identity as a founding member of the Welfare League. This paper examines Anderson's vision of "Eurasianness" in relation to broader social changes of the time, and the particular role he imagined Eurasians playing in the fight against colonial racial hierarchies and exclusion.
