# 北京大學歷史學系羅新教授主講「游牧民族如何參與中國歷史之創造」 Prof. Luo Xin from Peking University Delivered a Public Lecture on How Nomads Participated in the Creation of Chinese History (2018.3.16)

**游牧民族如何參與中國歷史之創造**

主講嘉賓：羅新 歷史學博士、北京大學歷史學系教授，主要研究領域為中國中古史和中國古代邊疆民族史。

中國的歷史常常被當做一部分人將該地視為漢族的歷史，似乎只有漢族人群才是中國歷史的創造者，而實際上曾經與漢族人群反覆對抗的人群，特別是草原地帶的游牧民族，則被視為中國歷史的挑戰者、干擾者及破壞者。羅新教授主要研究領域為中國中古史和中國古代邊疆民族史，他指出，中國歷史是所有古代人民共同的創造，歷史與歷史敘述之間，是一場無止無休的競爭，令歷史記載和講述或會被誇大、被忽略、被遺忘、甚至被掩藏。中國歷史上各個時期，都有相當數量的非華夏人群加入華夏社會，這些人群都要通過不同途徑實現其文化轉型，逐漸演變成現今的文明。

在過去幾千年的時間裏，當中原地區發生戰亂時，游牧民族會趁機南遷，有組織地進攻，使得北方地區的政治或經濟受到影響，甚至發生民族融合。

本講座以北方草原地帶的游牧民族為例，說明他們如何參與了中國歷史的創造。

Prof. Luo Xin, Department of History, Peking University delivered a Public Lecture on “How Nomads Participated in the Creation of Chinese History” on 16 March 2018. This event was co-organized by the Department of History at HKBU, Our Hong Kong Foundation and the China Institute.



Prof. Luo mainly focused on the research of Middle Ages and the ancient ethnic communities of China. He emphasized that Chinese history is a joint creation by all ancient people. History and history narratives may be exaggerated, ignored, forgotten, or even hidden. It is recorded that in every period of Chinese history, there was a large group of non-*huaxia* people migrating to the Chinese society, achieving different forms of cultural transformations, and gradually evolving into modern civilization.

The 360° View on China Lecture Series organized by the Our Hong Kong Foundation and the China Institute has come to the third round, attracting nearly 300 audiences. The Lecture was hosted by Prof. Chang Hsin Kang, Honorary President of China Institute of Our Hong Kong Foundation and Former President and University Professor, City University of Hong Kong.

HIST 3126 Fieldtrip:  
Heritage of Mid Imperial China in Guangzhou (2018.3.10)

On 10 March 2018, we visited a number of buildings and heritages and observed that Guangzhou was the hub and entrepot of maritime trade in China which exported commodities such as vessel, tea and silk. In the past, people set sail from the pier in front of the temple of South Sea God (南海神廟). Guangxiao Temple (光孝寺) was the centre of sutra translation and preaching for the monks. Huaisheng mosque (懷聖寺) and the “Tower of Light” 光塔 were built by Muslims who lived in the foreign quarter of Guangzhou in the Tang dynasty. This fieldtrip enabled us to learn about the culture diversity of Guangzhou in the mid-imperial period. The fieldtrip was financially supported by the Department of History and MHRC.

## 公開講座：《易經》與易學

### A Public Lecture on "Yijing and Yijing Commentaries" (2018.3.13)



歷史系很榮幸邀請香港城市大學中文與歷史學系韓子奇教授(Prof. Tze-ki Hon, Department of Chinese and History, City University of Hong Kong; Professor of Imperial and Modern China, Geneseo, State University of New York)光臨演講。韓教授先後任教於Hanover College 和紐約州立大學Geneseo分校，多年來在美國進行學術研究。

是次演講題目是「《易經》與易學」，《周易》是中國的古老經典，內容豐富，包括卦象、卦辭、爻辭、和《十翼》等部分。坊間一般把《周易》歸類為占卜算命，忽略了從漢代到清代《周易》是士大夫必讀的「儒家經典」，並寫下不少的注疏演繹「生生之謂易」的道理。二千年來，易學研究不斷蓬勃發展，推進了天文學、醫學、哲學、政治學、和行為心理學的發展。韓教授於講座中專門介紹兩種易學：漢代的象數易學和唐、宋時期的義理易學，簡要介紹易學的豐富內容。



韓教授在總結時特別提到《易學》對現今世界的意義，是讓人思考面對變易的態度，在應對生活中的衝擊時應如何自處，也藉「吉凶悔吝」啟發人們的多元思維，最後是提高我們對紛亂世界的憂患意識。





## MHRC Lecture Series on Public History (2): An Oral History Approach to the Soul Searching of Values and the Meanings of Life: Religious Discourse, Social Participation, and Identity Construction of Hong Kong Protestant Christians from 1970 to 1997 (2018.3.20)

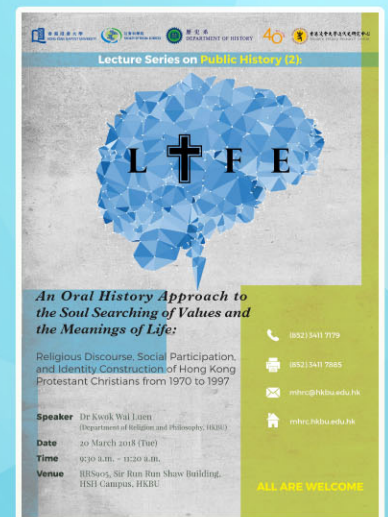

Dr. Wai-luen Kwok (President of Society for the Study of History of Christianity in China) was invited to deliver a lecture on Public History: An Oral History Approach to the Soul Searching of Values and the Meanings of Life: Religious Discourse, Social Participation, and Identity Construction of Hong Kong Protestant Christians from 1970 to 1997.

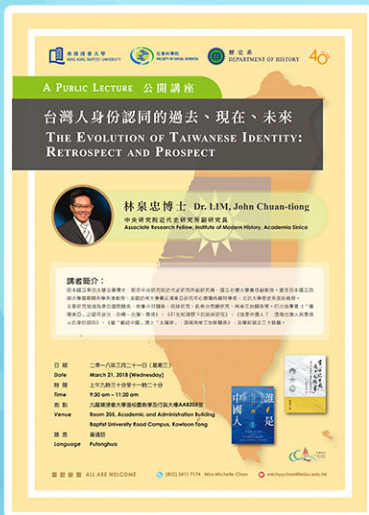
Sharing some findings from his GRF project, Dr. Kwok discussed the identity construction of Protestant Christians who were at the forefront of social and political movements in Hong Kong during the last three decades of the colonial era. He took into account of such key factors as networking, personal religious commitment, churches' reactions to social and political issues, and the last Governor' political agenda.

Moreover, Dr. Kwok examined promises and limitations in the use of oral history approach. In the first place, he explained the reason why oral history is a necessary device for this research, and how it could be useful for similar projects in people's history. Subsequently, he positioned oral history as a form of narrative inquiry. As such, he developed a schema of what he calls the "Narrative Cycle," with which he showed how skills and methods could be useful in facilitating an in-depth dialogue between the interviewer and the interviewee. Specifically, he elaborated on an interpretive matrix of "Holistic-Categorical" and "Content-Form" from relevant literature in the field of hermeneutics, and how it could enable researchers to better understand the contents from oral history interviews.





## 公開講座：台灣人身份認同的過去、現在、未來 A Public Lecture: The Evolution of Taiwanese Identity: Retrospect and Prospect (2018.3.21)



中央研究院近代史研究所副研究員林泉忠博士 (Dr. John Chuan-tiong Lim, Associate Research Fellow, Institute of Modern History, Academia Sinica) 於3月21日光臨演講，題為「台灣人身分認同的過去、現在、未來」。林博士是日本國立東京大學法學博士，現任中央研究院近代史研究所副研究員、國立台灣大學兼任副教授。他主要的研究領域為東亞國際關係，側重中日關係、琉球研究、釣魚台問題研究、兩岸三地關係等。已出版專著《「邊陲東亞」之認同政治：沖繩、台灣、香港》、《21世紀視野下的琉球研究》、《誰是中國人？：透視台灣人與香港人的身份認同》、《當「崛起中國」遇上「太陽傘」：透視兩岸三地新關係》，及學術論文三十餘篇。

林博士又剖析了戰後台灣社會認同的變遷及「中國」概念的建構和影響，從而解釋人們對成為中國人和台灣人的身份認同感及未來的挑戰。

是次講座中，林博士提到台灣人身分認同的歷史概況、發展和變化。他首先解構「身份認同」的定義，是支撐個人身份的意識內涵，而每個人因自身經歷、背景和接觸的事物，對身份認同的認知有不一樣的理解和強烈程度。

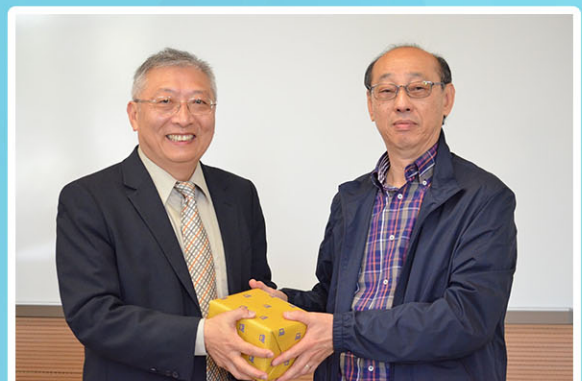
## 敵友之間：蔣介石與日本、中共(2018.3.23)



中央研究院近代史研究所研究員黃自進教授 (Prof. Tzu-chin Huang, Institute of Modern History, Academia Sinica) 於3月23日光臨演講，題為「敵友之間：蔣介石與日本、中共」。黃教授是臺灣師範大學歷史學系兼任教授，曾任香港中文大學臺灣研究中心訪問學者、清華大學歷史系客座教授。黃教授長期致力於近代中日關係史研究、近代日本政治思想史研究、近代日本外交史研究。出版專書包括《蔣介石與日本：一部近代中日關係史的縮影》（臺北：中央研究院近代史研究所，2012年）、《阻力與助力之間：孫中山、蔣介石親日、抗日50年》（北京：九州出版社，2015年）等。



黃教授在講座中主要提到兩個問題焦點：蔣介石與日本、中共之間關係的演變及蔣介石在反共抗日之間的建國藍圖與抗敵方針。他先講解蔣在日本接受教育與他形成自身人格的關係。黃教授又提到「不抵抗政策」的由來、「滿洲國」的建立，包括關東軍的收編以及東北軍的倒戈及「安內攘外」政策的再定義，以及對日蘇先戰的期盼。最後，他又強調了蔣介石對戰後日本重建的貢獻。

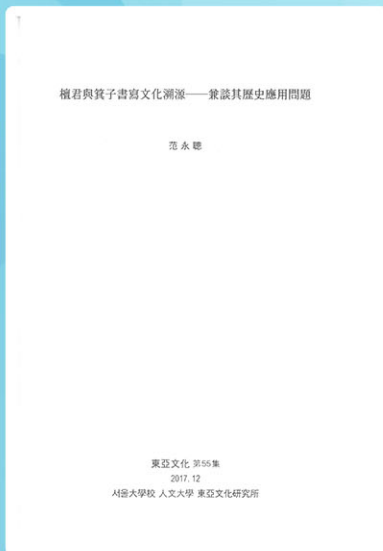

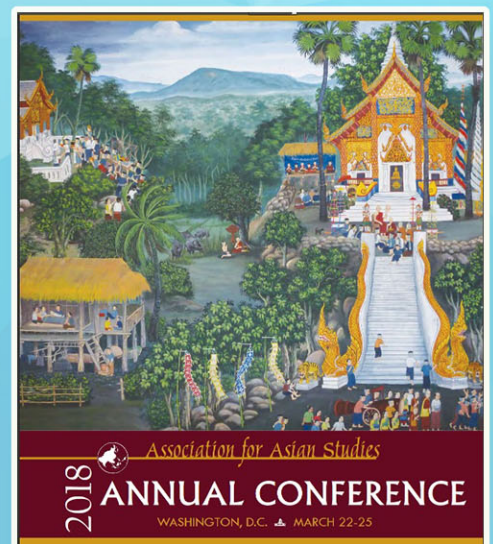

## Dr. Chi-man KWONG 鄺智文博士

灣仔炸彈記

二月底，工程人員在灣仔的沙中線地盤發現兩個戰時炸彈，警方於三日內封鎖灣仔北主要幹道數小時進行拆彈工作，港島交通大受影響。幸好警方拆彈成功，事件無造成傷亡。事後，我接受媒體查詢，再找了以往研究的資料，大致有以下的觀察：

兩個被發現的炸彈都是美國海陸軍在第二次世界大戰期間使用的M-65型通用炸彈（M-65 General Purpose Bomb）。此炸彈屬於空投炸彈，無任何導向裝置，彈長170厘米，最大直徑47.8厘米，彈重471.74公斤（1,040磅），內含炸藥269.89公斤（595磅）。此彈內的炸藥比一枚重砲彈多出數倍至數十倍不等，因為它的對象主要是無裝甲的目標，如建築物、運輸船隻、車輛等，因此沒有可以穿透裝甲的厚重彈體。正因如此，如果在市區引爆，後果可大可小。

至於為何會在灣仔找到美軍的炸彈？這是由於香港在第二次世界大戰期間是華南地區的重要海港；在第二次中日戰爭初期，國民政府從香港輸入了大量軍火和戰略物資，香港亦是各國情報組織的活動之地。1937至1941年間，英國堅持駐軍香港，希望以此舉加強國民政府的抗日信心；日軍佔領香港後，則打算把它用作與南洋聯繫的海運樞紐。為阻止日軍有效利用香港，美國陸軍航空隊在1942年10月至戰爭結束期間，多次對香港進行空襲。海軍亦於1945年1月15、16兩日對香港進行大規模的空襲。

當時日本海軍佔用金鐘的海軍船塢，其對開海域即為錨地，亦即今日發現炸彈的地點。為協助美軍發現目標，身在香港的英軍間諜（隸屬英軍服務團 British Army Aid Group）取得日軍在港情報，包括日本港務局的海港圖，使美軍得以順利攻擊停泊在港內的軍艦和船隻。不過，部份情報人員亦被日軍發現殺害。

由此事可見，歷史有時近在身邊，而且表面看似遙遠的軍事歷史，其實對我們理解香港的城市發展以至國際地位，並非全無助益。

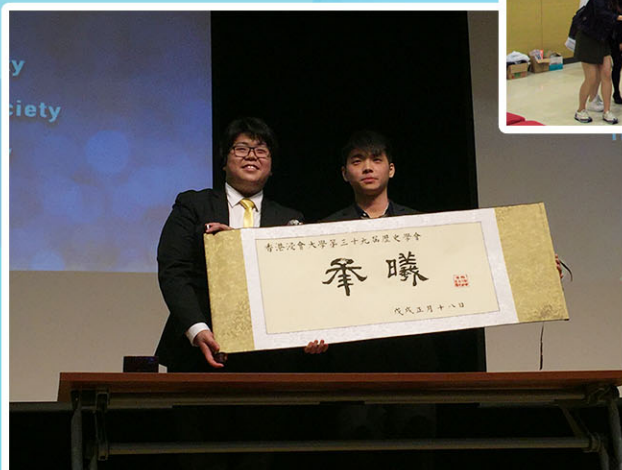

教育工作者的生活點滴：擔任中學老師有感

不經不覺離開浸會大學已經十年，很高興能夠在這裡分享一下自己擔當老師的一些經歷。

面對跟自己不一樣的學生

相信大家也是社科院或中研的同學，公開試也有著不錯的成績，絕大部分也不是來自banding較低的學校，可是給予我最深刻回憶的，卻是這些學術能力稍遜的學生。



記得第一年教書的時候，我在大埔區一間村校工作，當時擔任中一班主任，在這33個學生裡，有13個是SEN (Special Education Needs)的學生；當時的我馬上要社工上身，對視障、聽障、過度活躍症等等要有深入的認識，以便在日常生活多加留意，例如在那個學生參與考試時，出卷時字體要大一點；又例如那個學生在班房時，要留意他與他的行為狀況，調位又要有甚麼安排，誰又與誰不能坐在一起，少一點敏銳度也不行。

雖然有時面對這些學生真的很乏力，可是當你了解到他們作為SEN的痛苦，也實在只能多添耐性關心他們；而當他們有一點點的成長時，又或者看見他們畢業後長大成人，那份滿足感卻又是難以形容的。

面對跟自己不一樣的家長

小時候父母雖然對我的學業有期望，惟他們也稱不上「怪獸家長」。怪獸家長這個詞彙相信大家也並不陌生，我們也避不了跟家長相處，坦白說在直資學校任教期間，家長的確有不少要求；不過，當跟他們認真地探討學生的需要時，我也開始學習從不同角度思考這些家長與學生的特點。

我第二個工作的地方是一所直資學校，學生多來自中產家庭，他們的家長不乏專業人士，有心理學家、醫生護士，甚至有些本身就是老師。對，他們對老師的工作會有點要求，也的確有家



長動輒便會致電學校跟你「商討」事宜。可是，來自這些家庭的學生卻有著較有養份的成長，他們每每多才多藝，語文能力較高、視野也較廣闊。雖然跟家長們相處時也同樣需要耐性，可是當明白到他們如何希望望子成龍，有時對他們多一份體諒，自己也會輕鬆多一點。

### 面對自己熟悉的課外活動

最後，也分享一下自己作為歷史科老師的學趣。相信大家都同意，學習不應限制於書本之內，記得在中研讀書期間，也有不少機會參與不同類型的考察，當中在北京的日子，每星期在天安門、十三陵、長城、故宮、天壇等歷史名勝遊走，實在難忘。擔任中史老師，我們其實不乏機會帶領學生離開班房，在各歷史現場實地考察。

在這十年的教學生涯內，曾赴北京、上海、南京、廣州等大城市。我比較喜歡在參觀前首先跟學生進行講解，又或者先教授相關課程，學生在進入景點或名勝時自然更專注；記得參觀故宮時在軍機處、養心殿外討論清集權，在南京大屠殺紀念館時的肅穆，在大元帥府感受孫中山的無奈時，便知道他們會能體會這些歷史事件，教學實在事半功倍。

另外，我在香港也曾帶領學生到不少保育景點進行交流，了解史地文化，最容易入手的考察是在出身地開始；在校工作也有乏味時，帶學生在各區走走，在美荷樓聽聽講解、然後在北河街吃吃公和豆腐花、在藍屋研究研究、然後在利東街拍照，一同考察各區文化，有助學生擴闊視野，同時也能與學生建立更良好的關係。

◆ Abstract

This paper examines the founding of Hong Kong's Welfare League in 1929, led by a group of prominent Eurasians in the colony. I argue that the founding of this organization was a watershed event in the institutionalization of Eurasian identity in pre-World War II Hong Kong. Prior to this time, many prominent Eurasians in the colony publicly claimed a Chinese identity, both as a means to escape colonial racism and as a means of upward mobility. I argue that an "ethnic shift" took place among Hong Kong's Eurasian community around the time of the formation of the Welfare League, leading many in the younger generation to publicly embrace a "Eurasian" identity. C.G. Anderson (1889-1949) played a leading role in defining a vision of this identity as a founding member of the Welfare League. This paper examines Anderson's vision of "Eurasianness" in relation to broader social changes of the time, and the particular role he imagined Eurasians playing in the fight against colonial racial hierarchies and exclusion.
