Homecoming Evening in Commemoration of the 40th Anniversary of the Department of History

歷史系四十周年誌慶校友之夜 (2018.12.1)



To commemorate its 40th Anniversary, the Department of History has organized a host of academic lectures and celebratory events in 2018.

The Department presented the Homecoming Evening, in collaboration with the Alumni Affairs Office, as the grand finale of the year at SCC 201 on 1 December 2018. Over 300 alumni from different classes, HKBU senior management, supporters, current students, former and current faculty members participated and enjoyed a memorable reunion. Three former professors, Prof. J. Barton Starr, Prof. James A. Stewart Jr., and Prof. Daniel Y.K. Kwan flew in from North America to join this grand reunion.

The reception and cocktail session started at 5:30 pm. Guests were welcome to sign and take pictures at the backdrop specially designed for the celebration. Three videos, including a video highlighting celebratory activities in 2018, a music audio of the History Department anthem, and a video recalling the kick-off ceremony of the Department's 40th Anniversary on 2 Feb were played continuously before the stage programme started.

The stage programme started at 6:30 pm. Prof. Ricky Wong, Associate Vice-President (Teaching and Learning) cum Academic Registrar led the audience in singing the HKBU anthem. A welcome remarks was delivered by President Roland Chin on the latest development of HKBU's Institutional Strategic Plan. He showcased some of the achievements by alumni for the betterment of society.

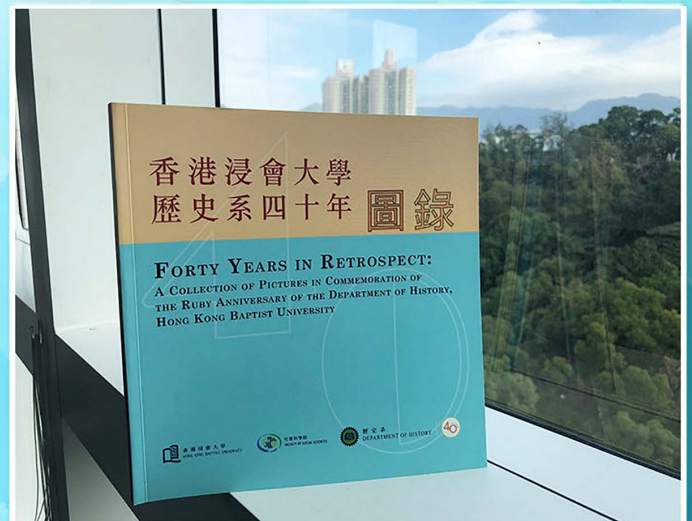

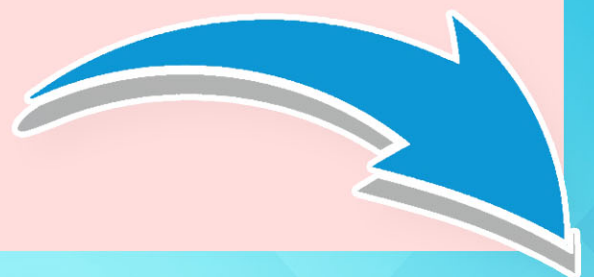

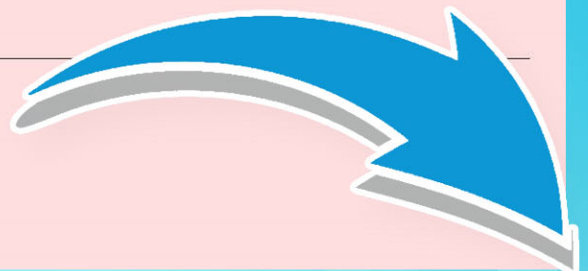

A Distinguished Alumni Lecture - Printing Technology, Book Culture, and the World of Print in Imperial China (2018.11.29)



The Department of History organized a distinguished alumni lecture delivered by Prof. Kai-wing Chow (Class of 1976), Professor, East Asian Languages and Cultures / History / Medieval Studies, University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign on 29 November 2018.

A widely-recognized scholar in cultural and intellectual history, Prof Chow's scholarly interests include the history of thought, print culture, ritual, religion, lineage, legal and public culture of China from the tenth through the early twentieth century.

Prof. Clara Wing-chung Ho first provided a brief introduction of Prof. Chow. She then presented a souvenir to Prof. Chow on the department's behalf.



Prof. Chow shared his insights on the topic “Printing Technology, Book Culture, and the World of Print in Imperial China”. By explaining the history of printing technology development in imperial China, he focused on the technologies that produce multiple identical copies which are woodblock and moveable type printing. He concluded that printing, especially xylography had transformed literary practices both in governance and in the quotidian life of the Chinese in imperial China.

A Q&A session was chaired by Prof. Ricardo King-sang Mak and Dr. Rebecca Robinson.

Following the victory in 2017 HKBU Library Awards, the Department is delighted to announce again that two History students won the 2018 HKBU Library Awards for Excellence in Undergraduate Research. Miss Yuen-ching Hui (BA [Hons] in History, 2018) won the Award for her paper “Women's Rights, Abolition, and Moral Reforms in Second Great Awakening Movement: Women's Roles and Sphere,” and Miss Hoi-ching Leung (BA [Hons] in History, 2018) won the Award for her paper “Stereotyping Through Gender Lens: A Comparative Study of the First Generation of the Chinese and Japanese Immigrant in California”.

This is the first time that two students were both named as winners and an extra award of HK\$3000 has been made to award them. The two high-quality papers nominated by Dr. David Schley for the Award impressed the committee that they decided to present an extra award to encourage both students.

The HKBU Library Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Research was established in 2014 by the Library to support and encourage undergraduate research at the University. Selection Criteria include use of a broad range of search tools, thoroughness of the research process, creativity in the use of resources and accuracy and attention to detail.

Candidates for the Award are identified through nomination by faculty, and Winner and Honourable Mentions will be selected by the Selection Committee. The Winner will be awarded a cash prize of HK\$3,000, and each of the Honourable Mention recipients will be awarded a cash prize of HK\$500.

Title: Women's Rights, Abolition, and Moral Reforms in Second Great Awakening Movement: Women's Roles and Sphere

Nominating Faculty: Dr. David Schley, Department of History

Nominator and Selection Committee Comments: "This essay delves into the language of evangelical writers in the Second Great Awakening in order to examine how and why notions about gender changed in that period...Hui's findings are rooted in extensive research in primary and secondary sources—she has gone deep into the voluminous print culture of the age in order to locate relevant evidence. Even more impressive is the skill with which she interprets these materials. Her careful analysis draws out these contradictory strands in nineteenth-century culture, while her close attention to historiography grounds her argument in an ongoing conversation. This is fascinating work, and represents a semester's worth of research and interpretation"; "Demonstrate an excellent research process and using the relevant search tools in both library and others. Good search strategy developed. Pay high attention to detail."

Title: Stereotyping Through Gender Lens: A Comparative Study of the First Generation of the Chinese and Japanese Immigrant in California

Nominating Faculty: Dr. David Schley, Department of History

Nominator and Selection Committee Comments: "This paper draws on a wealth of primary and secondary evidence to investigate the ways in which white Americans applies gender stereotypes to Chinese and Japanese men and women, and to consider what effects those stereotypes had on immigration policy. In addition to citing major works of scholarship on this subject, Leung draws on primary sources including newspapers, cartoons, and government reports. Only by examining a range of sources as she has done here could she offer this sort of comparative analysis, one that crosses national and gender lines. This is a challenging task, and one Leung has accomplished admirably here"; "Uncovered an impressive array of primary sources, especially great use of comics/cartoons."



GCHC1026/GCFC1006 Hong Kong in World History Field Trips (2018.9.22- 11.3)

The course GCHC1026/GCFC1006 arranged four field trips for outdoor learning from late September to early November. Over 100 HKBU students from different disciplines and majors visited Tai Kwun (former Central Police Station), Hong Kong Museum of History, Hong Kong Heritage Museum and Hong Kong Museum of Medical Science. By visiting these signature heritages, students learned about the image of old Hong Kong through variety of historical items and learned how to connect knowledge and livelihood with the local stories and experiences.

The history of Hong Kong was not restricted within the local framework but interacted with the larger geographical extents, namely the nations, the regions, and ultimately the global world. Based on the stories of colonial period that the museums told us, students are required to think outside the box on the specialties of the metropolitan city, and even the influences to the external world.

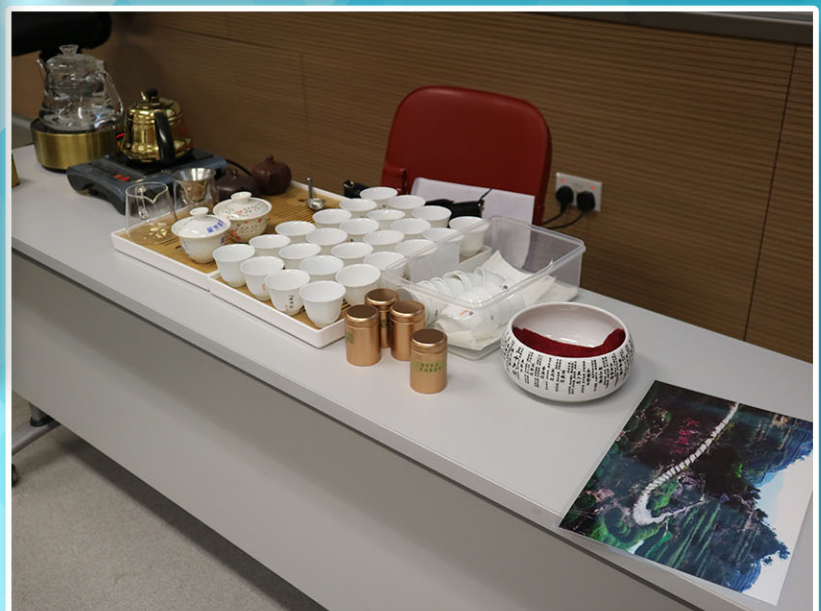

Peer Mentoring Program Debriefing (2018.12.21)



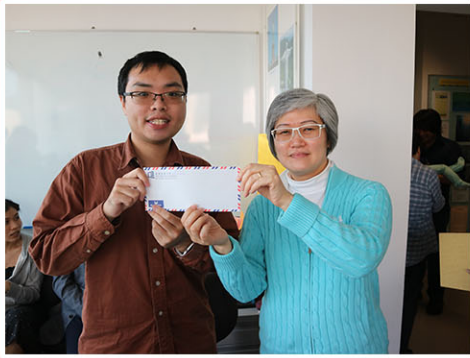

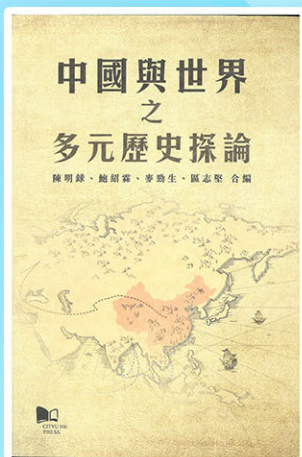

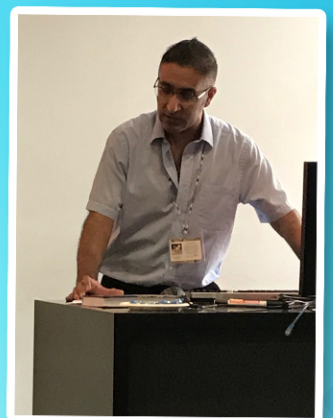

On Turning Forty

Four decades or forty years or four hundred and eighty months is not a long time in history, but is certainly long enough for an academic department in a 62-year-old college/university to accumulate wisdom so as to keep going onward and upward.

Since 1978, the Department of History has nurtured thousands of graduates, and it continues to grow and achieve new heights. According to the *HKBC Catalogue* published in the late 1970s and early 1980s, there were only one Lecturer, two Assistant Lecturers, one part-time Lecturer, and two Visiting Scholars when the department was newly set up, offering less than twenty courses on the menu. Now in 2018-19, we are a team of twenty two full-time academic and teaching staff, plus six part-time members. Also, we are offering sixty nine undergraduate History courses and twenty General Education courses. We admit students to three different major programs. Furthermore, according to the statistics of the Class of 2018, the History Minor program offered by us is the second largest minor program in the entire university. The department is fortunate to have dedicated colleagues and motivated students walking the 40-year journey along with us.

The department has gone through a full year of ruby anniversary celebration. This year is definitely a milestone. 離開浸大後，我會任職山東大學。山東大學以文史見長而知名於學界。到任後，需參加學院的科研工作、承擔本科生和研究生的課堂教學，並要當研究生指導老師。

好了，高鐵已離開山東，進入江蘇了。我也應該準備明天在上海師範大學的會議。就此擱筆。希望將來在學界再有機會與大家見面！

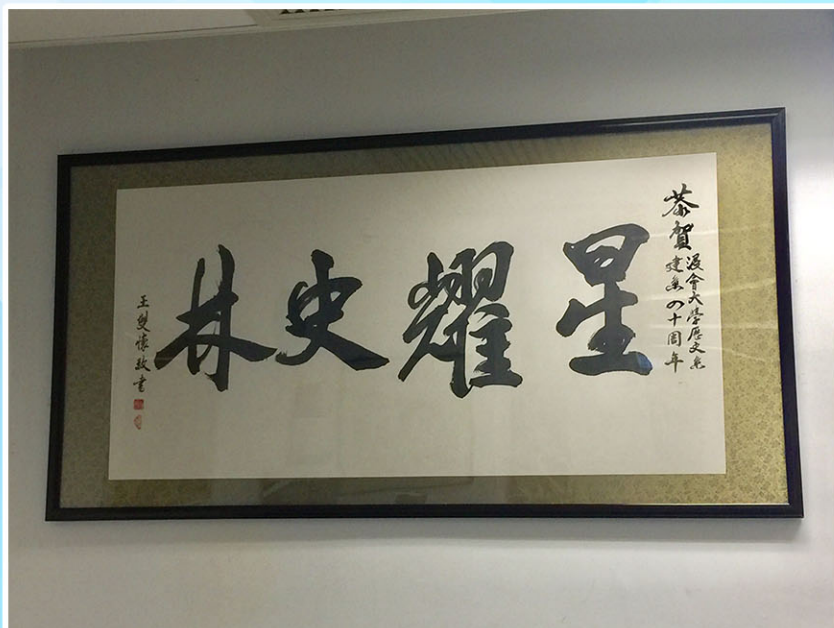

4. the skills to conduct research and manage large amounts of information, which is an essential skill for career success in the information age.

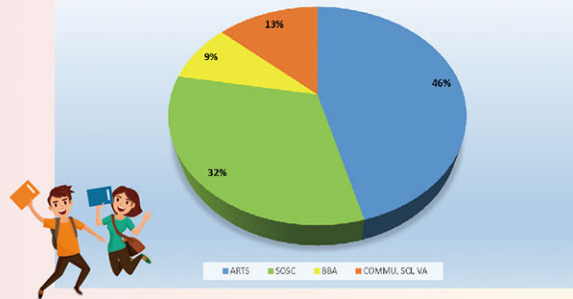
With regard to whole-person development, academic pursuits and career planning, a minor in History provides excellent training in analytical, argumentative and communication skills.
