Four Members of the Department Received Long Service Award 歷史系教職員獲頒長期服務獎 (2019.3.5)



The 63rd Founders' Day Thanksgiving Service of HKBU was held on 5 March 2019 at SCC 201. At the Service, President Professor Roland Chin showed his appreciation to Long Service Award recipients this year and thanked them for their dedicated service to the University over the years.

Among the 194 Long Service Award recipients, four recipients are members of the History Department. Three of them have served the Department for 25 years, they are: Prof. Stephanie Po-yin Chung (Professor), Prof. Ricardo King-sang Mak (Professor), and Ms. Renee Yuet-mei Chan (Secretary). Miss Crystal Ka-ying Poon (Secretary) also received her award of 10 years of service.

2018-19年度章群教授紀念公開學術講座
Professor Chang Chuen Memorial
Public Lecture Series 2018-2019 (2019.3.12)



「章群教授紀念公開學術講座」由已故章群教授的家人、舊生和同事共同捐款成立，以表彰這位創系系主任對香港浸會大學歷史系的重大貢獻。歷史系於2001年9月獲得首批捐款，並於2002年4月成立基金。2004年2月7日正式舉辦開幕典禮和首三場學術講座。

第二十一回章群教授紀念公開學術講座於2019年3月12日（星期二）圓滿舉行。中央研究院人文社會科學研究中心研究員劉序楓教授光臨演講，主題為「江戶時代的中日貿易與文化交流」，共有一百多位師生出席。劉序楓教授致力研究明清以來中國海洋發展史、中日關係史及東亞海域國際交流史。



劉序楓教授提到明末清初東亞海域的國際情勢及日本實施「鎖國」體制的原因，並概述長崎貿易的制度沿革、唐船貿易的流程、輸出入商品，中國商人在「唐館」內的生活，最後再介紹歸化日本的「唐通事」（負責貿易事務的中國語翻譯官）和渡日唐僧、文人等與日本人的交流和文化的影響。廖藹欣博士負責介紹講者，並主持問答環節。

The “Prof. Chang Chuen Memorial Public Lecture Series,” endowed with donations from the family of the late Prof. Chang Chuen and his former students and colleagues, was set up in the recognition of his valuable contribution to the Department and scholarship. Prof. Chang was appointed as the first Head of Department in 1978. The first donation arrived in September 2001 and the account was created in April 2002. The inauguration ceremony and the first three lectures were delivered on 7 February 2004.

The 21st round of the memorial lecture series was held on Tuesday 12 March 2019. Prof. Liu Shi-uh-Feng, Research Fellow of the Research Centre for Humanities and Social Sciences, Academia Sinica delivered a lecture on “Sino-Japanese Trade and Cultural Exchange during the Edo Period.” Over 150 students and faculty members attended the lecture.

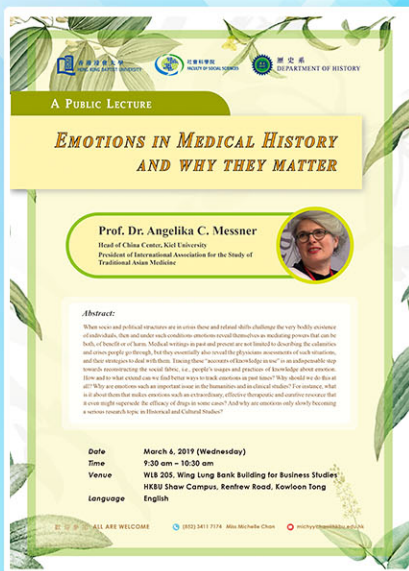
Examining the history of maritime East Asia during the Ming and Qing eras, Prof. Liu showed how Edo Japan, despite maintaining an isolationist policy, continued developing international exchanges across the East China Sea. He focused on the role of the Chinese junk trade in maintaining the Sino-Japanese trade, and the significance of Nagasaki as the main port where trade and cultural exchanges flowed through. Dr. Oiyan Liu introduced the speaker and served as moderator of the Q&A session.



A Public Lecture: Emotions in Medical History and Why They Matter (2019.3.6)



The Department of History invited Prof. Angelika C. Messner, Head of China Center, Kiel University and President of International Association for the Study of Traditional Asian Medicine as a guest speaker on 6 March 2019 to discuss the importance of emotions in medical history and related studies.



Emotions only recently are becoming a serious research topic in Historical and Cultural Studies. In her lecture “Emotions in Medical History and Why They Matter”, Prof. Messner offered intriguing insights into why and how this came about. Chinese medical sources tell much about how emotions were done in ordinary and extraordinary situations, and about what physicians thought and knew about the making of emotions and about what they can do within the corporeal realities of people. Medical sources offer fine grained knowledge in regard to emotions. They tell much about why and how emotions were seen as real forces of life. Finally, Prof. Messner emphasized that emotions are important engines of scientific inquiry. The Q&A session was facilitated by Dr. Natalie Koehle.

歷史系於3月6日舉辦講座，邀請德國基爾大學中國研究中心主任及亞洲傳統醫學國際研究協會會長史安梅教授演講，討論情緒在醫學史和相關研究中的重要性。

「情緒」近年才成為歷史和文化研究中愈見重要的課題。史安梅教授對醫學史中有關情緒的研究及其影響，提出了有趣的見解。中國的醫學理論提出了很多在普通或特殊情況下情緒形成的原因，又探討過情緒如何影響人體的身體狀況。最後，史教授強調情緒可以成為科學研究的一項重要工具。

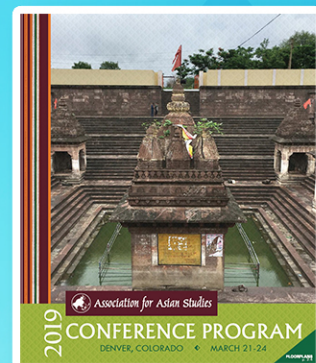

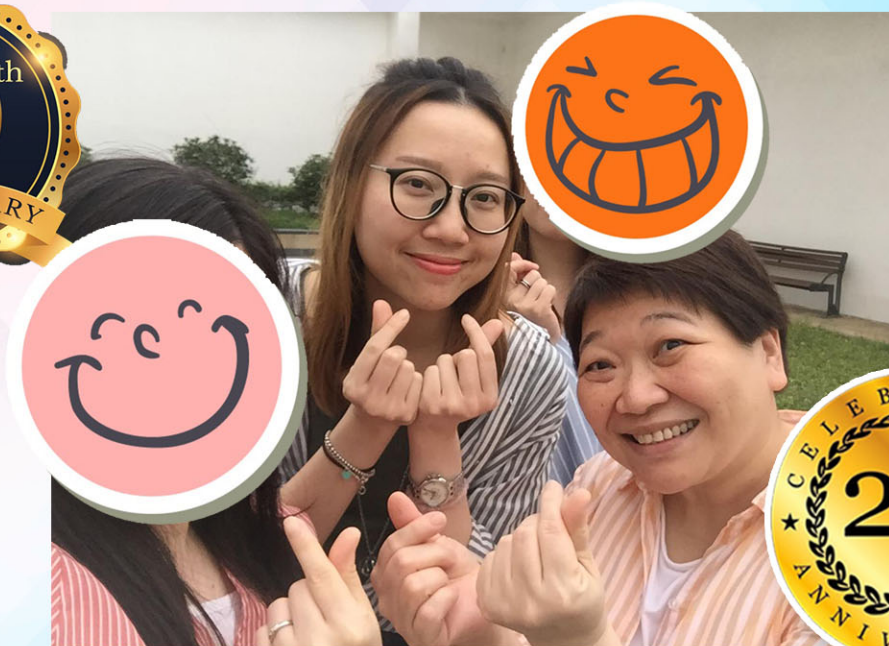

每座建築有段古



這幾年在長洲工作的時光，工作上雖然同歷史專業沒有直接關連，但原來「歷史」仍是離我不遠的。經歷前年及去年的超級颱風來襲，山頂道一帶不少參天的松樹都不堪倒下，雖然是有點可惜，但換來的是沿路的視野確實煥然一新。我工作的神學院也不例外，請放心！這裏的建築物很穩固，我入職最初半年多的辦公地點是學院在香港最早的建築之一，也是今天僅存的一座，就是用花崗石塊砌成的，牆身厚兩公尺。同事說這座建築比上世紀八九十年代擴建和重建的，在冬天或季風凜冽時更使人感到暖和，學院位處於坐北向南的高崗上，風勢其實不弱。

去年，颱風山竹當然絲毫沒有把這座超過六十年的石屋動搖，但外牆批灰不免有所破損，卻呈現了它初建時的部份外貌。學院便在十二月冬季學期開課前，盡早進行裝修，把舊的批灰全部刮掉，誰知在建築物近學院門樓的一角牆身露出直書的黑粗字體，寫上「華南建道聖經學院」。為什麼當時不叫「神學院」，要專稱「聖經學院」？這跟宣道差會的源起，以及十九世紀基督新教自由派跟後來興起的福音派對於神學教育的爭議有關。我還是從跟進系統神學科目的視像教材，才知道箇中的歷史，是一匹布那麼長的。



簡單來說，百年前宣道差會在梧州創辦建道神學院，是刻意用上「聖經學院」，以區別於當時基督新教裏以自由主義主導的神學院，這些神學院雖說是研究基督宗教，或培養神學工作者及牧者，但可以否定聖經的權威，甚至不講聖經，借其他學科研究信仰。這時，一些重尋信仰根源的牧者和神學工作者不願意接受這樣的神學教育，更不想下一代信徒領袖接受這樣思想教育，便另起爐灶，辦起自己的「神學院」，他們標舉回歸聖經的旗幟，所以學校通通採用「聖經」二字。他們就是福音派的先鋒。學院就是在這樣的思潮背景下誕生，所以直到上世紀六十年代都是採用「聖經學院」這稱號。當然，後來福音派成為基督新教的主流以後，不少歷史悠久的神學院已不再那麼強調自由主義的神學思想，福音派也漸漸重新接受「神學院」這名稱。這個歷史印記也隨著這次重修，再度埋在混凝土裏，委實有點可惜！

近兩年，自己在閒暇會重尋一些在新界「不復舊貌」的書室，透過從政府新聞處圖片資料組和地政總署測繪處的地圖及航空照片資料室搜集到上世紀七十年代或以前的黑白舊照片和航空照片，重構這些書室重修前恢宏的規模，絢麗的格調，精巧的裝飾。同時，也讓我更多認識到書室背後一族一房的源流和發展，明白到籌建者對後代的心意和展望。這些書室在上世紀七八十年代等待不及政府所主持的修復，便自行重建起來。儘管復修無望，我只想這份業餘的習作讓大家更認識廣東地區村落的傳統建築的活潑和多元，珍視傳統工匠的巧手和心思。

現在，剛剛轉到香港中央圖書館上班，主要從事文獻整理和研究的工作，希望早點適應新工作環境，可以重拾和完成這份未完的習作。

發現古書與發現古史 —— 出土文獻與重寫中國古史 UNEARTHING HISTORY: EXCAVATED MANUSCRIPTS AND REWRITING THE EARLY CHINA

提要：

自20世紀疑古派對所謂「五千年文明」提出質疑後，中國古史學界都糾結於疑古、信古與釋古之中。站在21世紀的今天，學界已不滿足於單靠傳世文獻來構建古史體系，出土文獻對於補充、印證、糾正古史就發揮前所未見的作用。經過學界長期整理和研究出土文獻資料，如今已具備相當充分的條件來重寫中國古史。本講座將以2008年搶救入藏的《清華簡》為例，說明出土文獻如何讓我們重寫與重新認識夏、商、周的古史，不單提升我們對古史的認識，亦給予我們在史學方法上的新啟示，從而帶出史學研究的正確態度是離不開對不同材料進行批判和分析。

個人簡介：

陳嘉禮，1988年生於香港，先後獲香港中文大學歷史學文碩士及香港浸會大學歷史學哲學博士。曾任美國芝加哥大學東亞系訪問學人、香港浸會大學歷史系講師、香港恒生大學社會科學系講師。現任山東大學儒學高等研究院副教授。主要研究興趣包括中國上古史、甲骨文及中國史學史。


