History Members Fighting the Virus

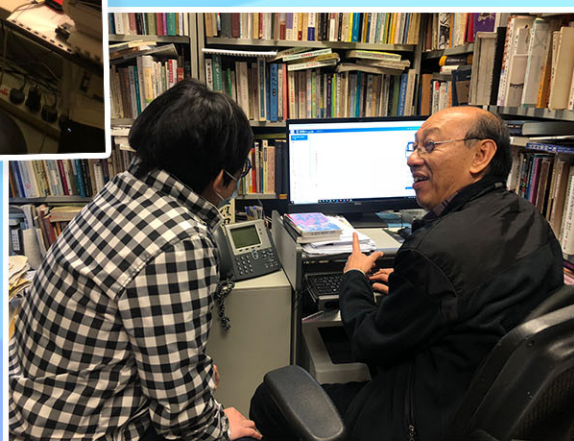
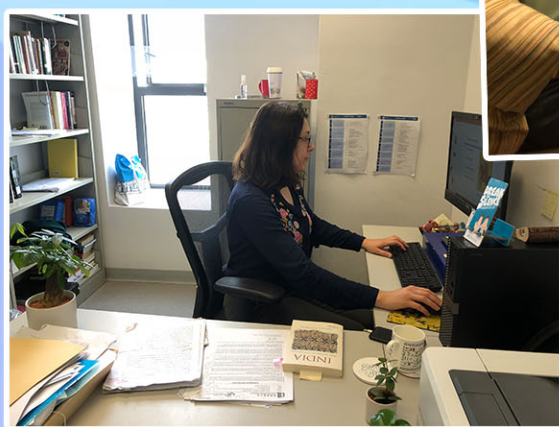
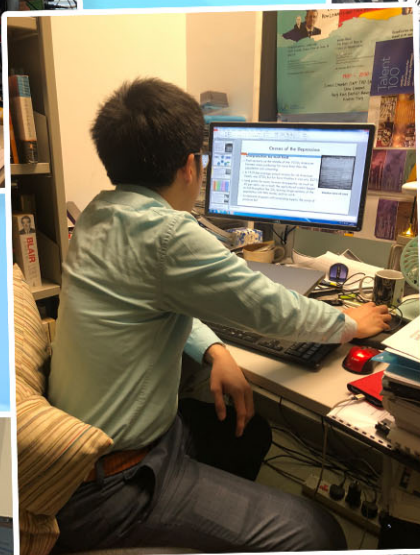
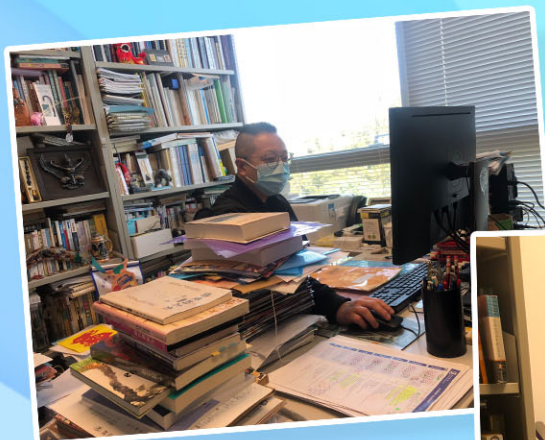
歷史系全人齊心抗疫

In view of the increasingly virulent novel coronavirus outbreak in Hong Kong, the University has decided to suspend on campus face-to-face classes and shift to e-Learning to avoid large meetings in classrooms, but still maintain the core activities of teaching and learning. Stringent preventive measures have been implemented on campus, such as thorough campus cleaning and infection control. All staff and students are requested to submit a health declaration form each day they wish to enter the campus.

Faculty members of the Department of History have made every effort to adopt to online teaching. Professors conduct their lessons via Zoom, Moodle, and PowerPoints with audio recordings, and upload teaching materials to Moodle for easy reference.

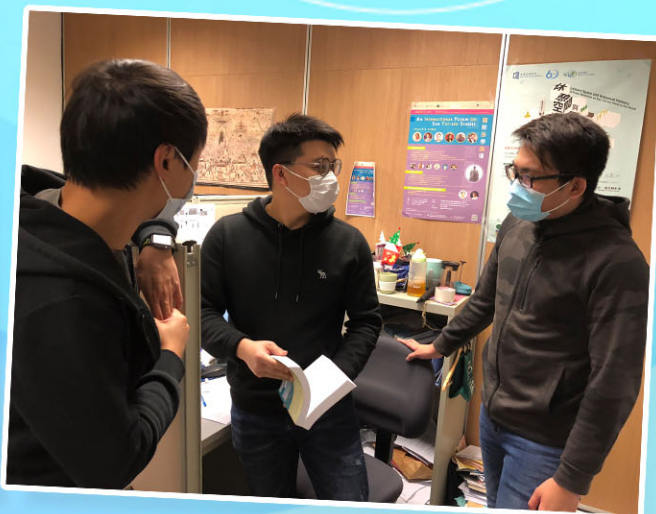
Tips to safeguard your health:

研究生講論會 Research Student Seminar (2020.2.20)



歷史系博士研究生趙橙於2020年2月20日完成其講論會，獲一眾老師指導提點。她的報告題目為「顯與隱：晚期帝制中國的江南園林與女性空間」，趙橙同學首先就其博士論文選題的可行性、創新性進行報告。報告共三部分，首先從明清園林史、明清女性空間、園林與女性關係三方面對相關研究論著予以簡單分析與回顧。其次，報告介紹了其博士論文寫作中行將運用到的理論方法與主要史料。最後，報告還重點分享了其博士論文的篇章架構，包括緒論、「抒陳幽懷的舞台」、「社交歡愉的天地」、「婦職教化的場域」、「情欲流動的空間」以及結論六部分。

報告結束後，出席本次講論會的老師，包括劉詠聰老師、朱益宜老師、李嘉鈴老師、李建深老師、廖藹欣老師及宗教及哲學系張穎老師分別向趙橙同學提出問題與指導意見。這些意見既肯定了其選題與構思的創新性，同時也非常中肯地指出了若干值得繼續斟酌與思考的問題，很具建設性。

教在瘟疫蔓延時

得知被Michelle邀請分享抗疫心得後，腦海馬上響起一首兒歌：「遇怪魔（武漢肺炎）我即刻變大個」。我們要變得更強大，更要比以往更健康，才能好好防止病毒的入侵。

除了清潔消毒外，我們助教也有新的體驗，就是學習使用最近引起廣泛討論的Zoom。對於Zoom，大家的反應都是老師們猶如KOL，每天直播最新的內容給學生，而學生就像訂閱者，每天準時收聽最新的資訊。故此，我最想跟大家分享的，就是協助老師們預備網上教學的過程，因為這些有趣的過程，你們難以想像，老師們亦不一定會談及。由於跟以往面對面授課的情況略為不同，老師們各有不同的想法和策略應對，例如：如何令兩小時或三小時的直播變得生動有趣之外，亦能維持跟同學之間的互動；如何在討論環節裡鼓勵學生踴躍發問，避免冷場。有些老師因而仿效電台主播，增加問答環節，或容許學生以電郵、電話，甚至通過zoom的語音功能，讓同學直接講出他們的答案。聞說課堂的氣氛很好，學生對這些方式大感興趣。我亦知道有老師嘗試以PPT加上錄音向同學授課，其後發現PPT隱藏的功能甚多，反而從中獲得額外的知識。當然，過程中不乏失敗的個案，導致重新講解了相同的內容，但也算是瘟疫蔓延時的獨特經歷，同學們不妨欣賞老師的一番心思。



最近因為疫情嚴重，大專院校轉為網上授課，推行彈性上班，使歷史系辦公室也變得比較冷清。不過，談起Zoom還是會很熱鬧，Zoom是一套視像會議軟件，因為服務比Skype和Hangouts可靠，近年被廣泛用於商務和教學用途，也是學校推薦的授課工具之一。

到底老師們對Zoom有什麼感覺呢？根據非正式調查，有些老師對Zoom非常讚賞，因為學生的互動和反饋非常熱烈，而平常課堂大家都是不說話的；有些老師很不習慣，因為要花更多時間準備；有些老師沒有感覺，因為他們根本沒有用Zoom，當然他們還是要拍片錄音。

為了幫助教職員應用網上教學，大學早前舉辦了一個網上工作坊，讓大家遙距學習遙距教育，透過親身試用Zoom來學習Zoom，我們兩個也有幸參與觀摩。工作坊的參與人數超過一百人，大家非常興奮，此起彼落，令原定一小時的工作坊最後要延長到超過兩小時，所以說知識是無窮無盡的。

經歷了一個不完整的學年，希望一切會有恢復正常的一天。

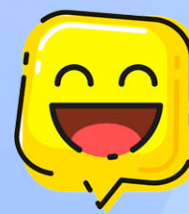
