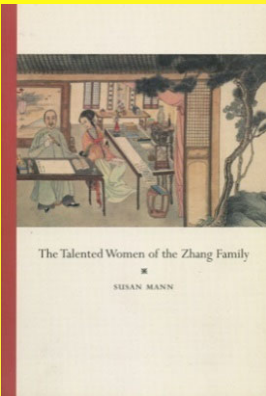

some of what you will read is my own conjecture and invention. Here I have followed a central tenet of Chinese historical writing, which strives to bring to life people from the past with their feelings, words, and deeds intact. My comments as the historian, which follow each section and fill the notes as well as the epilogue that concludes the book, feebly attempt to honor both the style and the critical standards set nearly two millennia ago by the great Han historian Sima Qian, who kept his lively historical narratives and his personal judgments separate.

The historian says:

Wang Caipin's life, like that of her employer, Xu Zhenyi, was framed by the millenarian movement known as the Taiping Rebellion. From its modest stirrings in 1851 far to the south of Caipin's home, the movement swept into the Lower Yangzi region and occupied it for more than a decade. The Taipings were not fully defeated until 1866, when their self-proclaimed "Heavenly Kingdom" collapsed. The rebellion shocked people like Wang Caipin
